COUNTY OF BRECKINRIDGE, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2012-1126

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 2011-0314 RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP CHARGES OR SUBSCRIBER FEES FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BRECKINRIDGE, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That Section II, Paragraph B, page 2, of Ordinance No. 2011-0314 is hereby amended as follows:

B. Breckinridge County Sheriff: Shall have the duty of collecting all taxes listed on the property tax bill. Upon collection, the Breckinridge County Sheriff shall have the duty to distribute the collected membership charges or subscriber fees while collecting taxes listed on the property tax bill. The Breckinridge County Sheriff shall distribute these fees to the respective volunteer fire departments. For the performance of his duties under this Ordinance, the Sheriff shall receive from the proceeds of all membership charges and subscriber fees collected, a sum of four and one-fourth (4.25%) percent of the total amount collected.

SECTION II: All provisions set out in full in Ordinance No. 2011-0314 and not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
